Clemson University

- Land Grant, Founded in 1889
- Located in Upstate SC (Greenville-Anderson-Mauldin MSA)
- Current Enrollment (Fall 2016): 23,406
 - 18,599 Undergrad
 - 4,807 Grad
- 5,222 Employees
- Previous study: total impact of University to SC in 2013:
 - 24,579 jobs (1.2% of total employment in state)
 - \$1.9 billion output (2010 dollars)
 - \$174.5 million net state gov. rev. impact (exceeding state appropriations for university by \$81.8 million)

While we're on the subject...

- Economic impact of average home football game (estimated 2011)
 - Tri-County (Pickens/Anderson/Oconee)
 - 109 jobs
 - \$4.3 million output
 - \$235,000 net local government revenue
 - State Total
 - 198 jobs
 - \$10.3 million output
 - \$733,000 net state government revenue





Model Inputs - Construction

- Clemson University Restoration Institute (CURI)
 - SCE&G Energy Innovation Center/Wind Turbine Drivetrain Test Facility (WTDTF) & Grid Simulator -- \$76 million between 2010-2016 (little bit in 2017)
- Zucker Family Graduate Education Center (GEC)
 - \$19 million between 2014-2017



Model Inputs - Operations

- CURI
 - Operational Expenditures (including compensation) for
 - Warren Lasch Center
 - SCE&G Energy Innovation Center
 - One tenant (private business)
- Zucker Family GEC
 - Operational Expenditures
 - Projected enrollment (200 total by 2025)
 - Student spending estimated from Harris poll, adjusted for inflation and local COL
 - Multiplied by projected # of out-of-state students




Model Inputs - Operations


- Clemson Architecture Center (CAC)
 - Operational Expenditures
 - Around 30 students per year
 - No state appropriations for CAC fully funded by tuition
- CU-MUSC BioE Program
 - Operational Expenditures
 - Capital equipment purchase
 - Around 25-30 students projected to grow to 50 by 2025














